Books of the Bible Genesis - Deuteronomy
1st Commandment You shall have no other gods.
What does this mean?
We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.

Due for October 2

Books of the Bible Genesis - Esther
2nd Commandment You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not use his name to curse, swear, lie, or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon God's name in every trouble, pray, praise and give thanks.

Due for October 9

Books of the Bible Genesis - Daniel
3rd Commandment Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but regard it as holy and gladly hear and learn it.

Due for October 16

Books of the Bible Genesis - Malachi
4th Commandment Honor your father and mother, that it may go with well with you and that you may enjoy a long life on the earth.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not dishonor or anger our parents and others in authority, but honor, serve, and obey them, and give them love and respect.

Due for October 23

Books of the Bible Matthew - 2 Corinthians
5th Commandment You shall not murder.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and befriend him in every bodily need.

Due for October 30

Books of the Bible Matthew - Philemon
6th Commandment You shall not commit adultery.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we a pure and decent life in words and actions, and that husband and wife love and honor each other.

Due for November 6

Books of the Bible Matthew - Revelation
7th Commandment You shall not steal.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not take our neighbor's money or property, or get it by dishonest dealing, but help him to improve and protect his property and means of income.

Due for November 13

- Bible Passage Romans 6:23 – The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 8th Commandment You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, or give him a bad name, but defend him, speak well of him, and take his words and actions in the kindest possible way.

Due for November 20

- Bible Passage 1 John 1:8,9 – If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 9th Commandment You shall not covet your neighbor's house.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or obtain it by a show of right, but do all we can to help him keep it

Due for November 27

- Bible Passage Ephesians 2:8,9 – For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- 10th Commandment You shall not covet your neighbor's spouse, workers, animals, or anything that belongs to him.
What does this mean?
We should fear and love God that we do not force or entice away our neighbor's spouse, workers, or animals, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

Due for April 1

Bible Passage John 11:25,26 – “I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die.”

Lord's Prayer, 2nd Petition

Thy kingdom come.

What does this mean?

God's kingdom certainly comes by itself even without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may also come to us.

How does God's kingdom come?

God's kingdom comes when our heavenly Father gives his Holy Spirit, so that by his grace we believe his holy Word and lead a godly life now on earth and forever in heaven.

Due for April 15

Bible Passage 1 Timothy 2:3,4 – God our Savior ... desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Lord's Prayer, 3rd Petition

Thy will be done on earth as it is heaven.

What does this mean?

God's good and gracious will is certainly done without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may be done among us also.

How does this happen?

God's will is done when he breaks and defeats every evil plan and purpose of the devil, the world, and our sinful flesh, which try to prevent us from keeping God's name holy or letting his kingdom come. And God's will is done when he strengthens and keeps us firm in his Word and in the faith as long as we live. This is his good and gracious will.

Due for April 22

Bible Passage James 1:17 – Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights; with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

Lord's Prayer, 4th Petition

Give us this day our daily bread.

What does this mean?

God surely gives daily bread without our asking, even to all the wicked, but we pray in this petition that he would lead us to realize this and to receive our daily bread with thanksgiving.

What, then, is meant by daily bread?

Daily bread includes everything that we need for our bodily welfare, such as food and drink, clothing and shoes, house and home, land and cattle, money and goods, a godly spouse, godly children, godly workers, godly and faithful leaders, good government, good weather, peace and order, health, a good name, good friends, faithful neighbors, and the like.

Due for April 29

Bible Passage

Matthew 28:19,20 – “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

Lord's Prayer, 5th Petition

Forgive our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.

What does this mean?

We pray in this petition that our Father in heaven would not look upon our sins or because of them deny our prayers; for we are worthy of none of the things for which we ask, neither have we deserved them, but we ask that he would give them all to us by grace; for we daily sin much and surely deserve nothing but punishment.

So we too will forgive from the heart and gladly do good to those who sin against us.

Due for May 6

Bible Passage

Mark 16:16 – Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Lord's Prayer, 6th Petition

Lead us not into temptation.

What does this mean?

God surely tempts no one to sin, but we pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us, so that the devil, the world, and our flesh may not deceive us or lead us into false belief, despair, and other great and shameful sins; and though we are tempted by them, we pray that we may overcome and win the victory.

Due for May 13

Lord's Prayer, 7th Petition

But deliver us from evil.

What does this mean?

In conclusion, we pray in this petition that our Father in heaven would deliver us from every evil that threatens body and soul, property and reputation, and finally when our last hour comes, grant us a blessed end and graciously take us from this world of sorrow to himself in heaven.
