L: The grace of the Lord + Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.

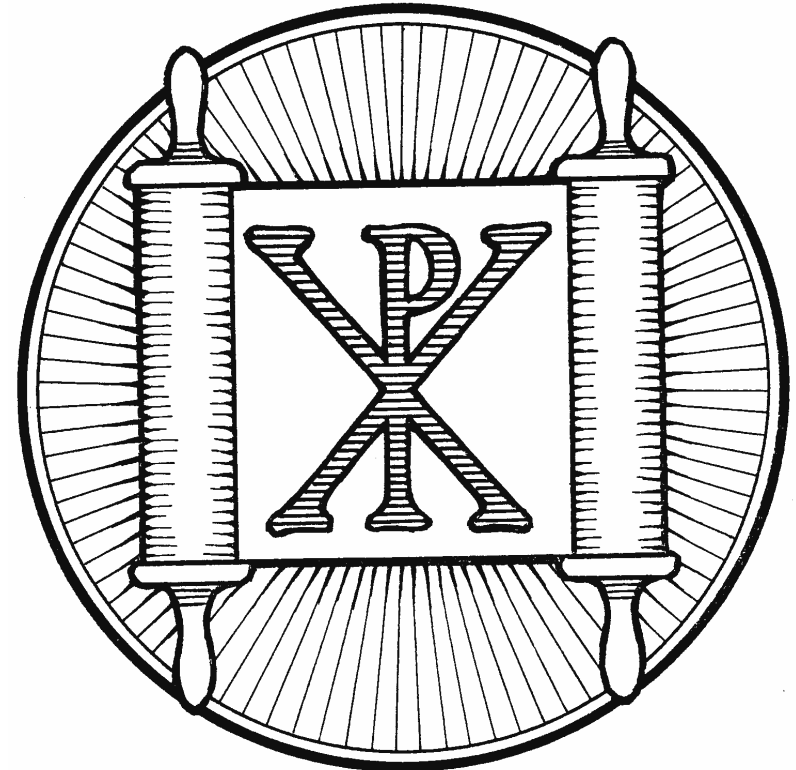
